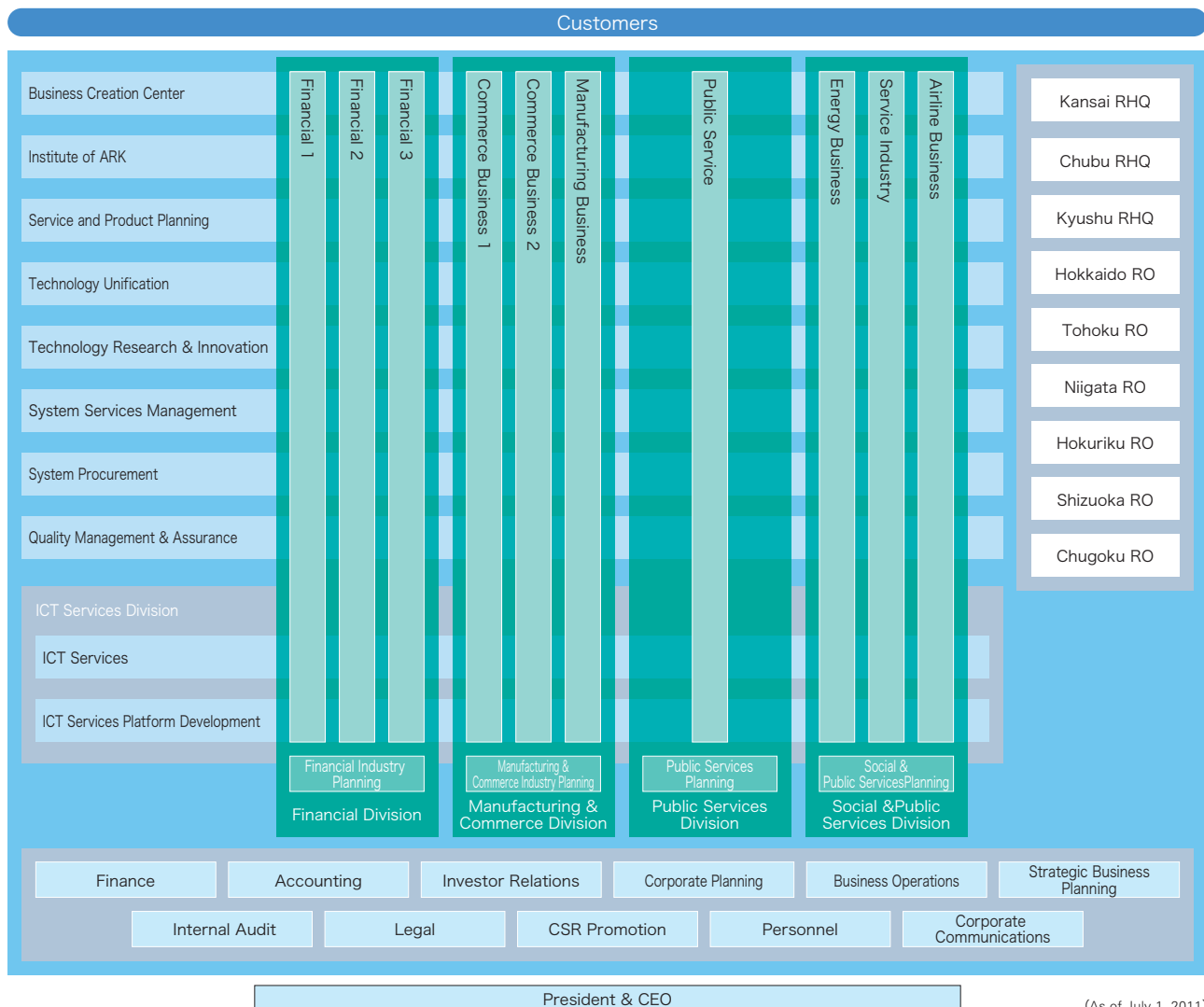

1955	Installed Japan's first computer, the "UNIVAC-120," at the Tokyo Stock Exchange and Nomura Securities Co., Ltd.	2004	Finance division of Nihon Unisys Software Ltd. (now USOL HOLDINGS Co., Ltd.), obtained Level 5 in CMMI.
1958	Nippon Remington Univac Kaisha, Ltd. founded. (later Nippon Univac)	2005	Newly established a dedicated organization to promote CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) activities. Established G&U System Service, Ltd. jointly with Gunze. 50 years have passed since UNIVAC 120, the first commercial computer was installed in Japan.
1962	Introduced "B5000", the world's first computer to combine hardware/software in its design.	2006	Nihon Unisys launched sales of mission-critical ES7000/one server series. We established USOL Vietnam Corporation in Hanoi Vietnam as our base for overseas software development subsidiary.
1964	First successful attempt at online real-time processing in Japan.	2007	Announced Evaluation frame based on the Practice standard corresponded with the Japanese version SOX method. Launched full banking system based on Microsoft Windows Server, SQL server for the first time in the world. Nihon Unisys accepted NETMARCS INC. into Nihon Unisys group as our group member.
